Tour Itinerary

- **Visit Baizid Bostami Majar:**

Our guide and driver will come to pick up from your hotel at 8.45 am and we start our tour visiting Baizid Bostami Majar which is considered to be a ritual place dedicatedly for the Muslim community but people of other religions paying their tribute to the tomb. The interesting thing about this place is there are some old rear turtles. These turtles are regarded as a secrete animal. People feed them as a symbol of the fulfillment of their wishes.

- **Visit of Chittagong Circuit House:**

This time we will be heading toward the city center and visit a museum located in Chittagong Circuit House which was built during the British regime in the subcontinent. This museum represents the life of one of the most famous presidents of Bangladesh Ziaur Rahman who was assassinated in this place.

- **Visiting City Center:**

This time we continue our tour to visit some landmarks of Chittagong city which was built by the British such as Railway Station, 7 Jongson roads, tiger pass, etc.

- **Lunch Break:**

By this time, you will be tired and hungry, we will take you to have lunch in a popular restaurant which will give you an authentic taste of Bangladeshi food.

- **Visiting Shipbreaking Yard Scrap Market:**

Visit the Vatieary Lake and strolling through the ship breaking yard scrap shop where you will have an opportunity to buy some souvenir the reusable thing coming from the Ship. This also will give you an aspect of the life of the workers of the so controversial ship-breaking yard of Chittagong.

- **Visiting Patenga Sea Beach and end of the tour:**

We will be ending up the tour visiting the Patenga Sea Beach and strolling through the beach marketplace. This place is the best for experiencing the roaring sea and its waves crashing over the stones that placed on the bank of the river to protect the city.

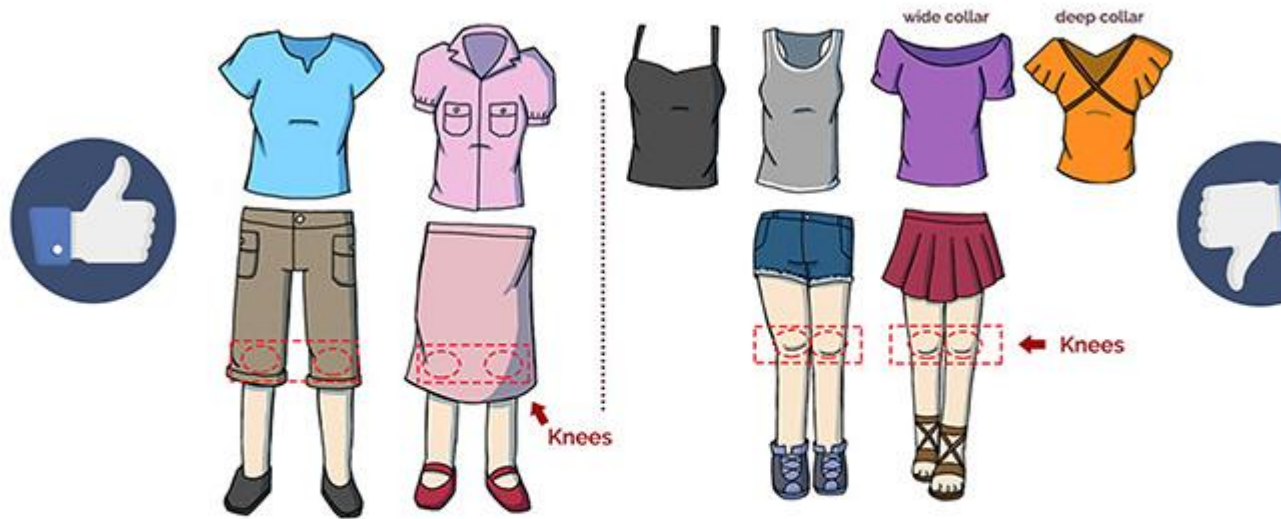
- **Merging this tour with Chittagong Ship-breaking yard tour.**

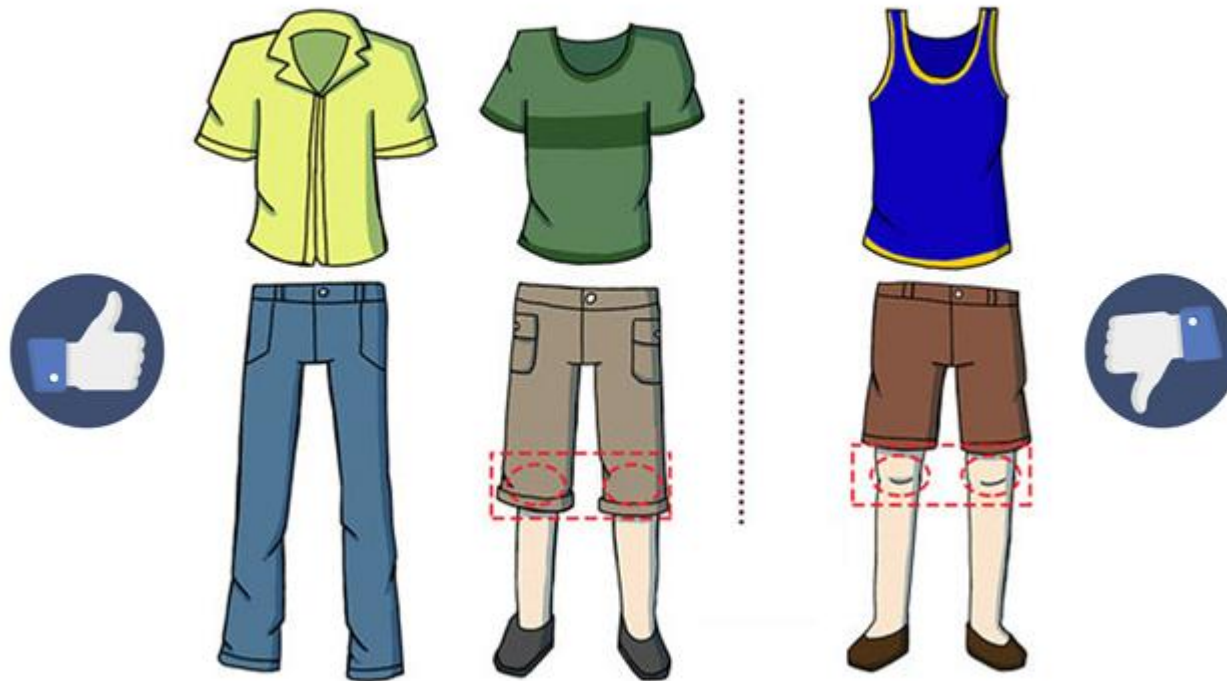
Dress code for women
